



Evaluation Top Tips

1) Capture stories

Stories provide glimpse of people's experience and are an important part of evaluation

2) Engaging evaluation

Use methods that provide a means to engage participants in evaluation

3) Evaluate within context

Reflect on the importance of the context and its impact on outcomes

4) Evaluation viewpoint

Use methods that help to understand things from the viewpoint of participants.

5) Creative evaluation breaks barriers

Creative event break down barriers, especially with those who are difficult to engage

6) Face to Face

Face to face interaction for evaluation can give a different perspective with participants

7) The long game

Objective evaluation can be achieved by long-term engagement with the participants.

9) Softer targets

Improving 'soft targets' such as self confidence and self esteem will help build better relationships.
