

Advice for printing this card deck

We've designed this card deck to be re-printable by so you can change the cards and get as many decks as you need.

There are a three of different ways you can print:

Moo.com

We use Moo.com for printing cards because they are quick and produce cards that are durable and feel really good in the hand.

Decks cost £14-18 depending on how many you order.

To order:

- Create an account on moo.com
- Set up an order for business cards (84x55mm) with rounded corners.
- Upload the artwork from the 'JPEGs' zip accompanying this tool:
 - Back.jpg for the front of cards (yes, it is strange)
 - Any images for the back - these could be questions, photos or other designs from the card deck (jokers etc).
 - You can add your own artwork starting from our template or from scratch.
- Place the order.

Office Printer

- You can print the Deck.pdf file using [Adobe Acrobat](#) available freely online.
- You might want to print each card to fill an entire page.
- Or, in the print settings, select 'Multiple' and ask for multiple pages per sheet.
- It is probably easiest to leave the backs of the cards blank.
- Once printed, cut out the cards or use them as they are.

Professional Print Shop

- Most professional printers will be able to take the Deck.pdf (and any other cards you've designed) and print them for you.
- Ask for a 'lamine' plastic coating to protect the cards.
- Ask for rounded corners to help make the cards easier to handle (and more durable).
- This is a good option if you need lots of decks.
